

CONSERVATION DISTRICT WATERSHED SPECIALIST

The Mifflin County Conservation District is seeking qualified candidates for the Watershed Specialist position. The Watershed Specialist's responsibilities include watershed assessment, procurement of funding (grant writing), technical assistance, and the creation, implementation and coordination of work plans and strategies to restore and protect groundwater and surface water resources in Mifflin County. The Watershed Specialist is required to submit monthly, quarterly and annual work reports, present programs and information to public organizations, facilitate environmental education events and field days, and work with local, state and federal government entities to promote resource conservation. The Watershed Specialist is under the direct supervision of the District Manager and the Mifflin County Conservation District Board of Directors.

The successful candidate will possess the following qualifications:

- A degree in Environmental Sciences, Natural Resource Management, Geoenvironmental studies, Geodesign, Biology or a related field.
- Proficiency with Microsoft Office programs, Adobe Suite, and ArcGIS. Familiarity with CAD and web mapping applications preferred.
- Effective verbal and written communication skills. Grant writing experience preferred.
- Experience with water quality assessment and monitoring, watershed restoration, stream restoration, and watershed implementation plans.
- Experience with project management, Chapter 105 permitting, best management practice (BMP) design and implementation, general construction, and BMP operation/maintenance.
- Must possess a valid PA driver's license.
- Must be able to perform physical labor and traverse various types of terrain.
- Experience working with hand tools, power tools, and small equipment preferred.
