The Mifflin County Conservation District is seeking qualified candidates for a Resource & Agriculture Conservation Specialist. The Resource & Agriculture Conservation Specialist responsibilities include:

- Chapter 102 E&S Control Program: plan reviews, site inspections, reporting.
- Countywide Action Plan: outreach and communication, BMP implementation, project planning, project management and facilitation, collaboration with County Action Plan Coordinator.
- Agricultural Conservation Assistance Program: outreach and education, application ranking, BMP implementation, project management and facilitation, quarterly and annual reporting.

The successful candidate will possess the following qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree in environmental sciences, natural resource management, environmental/agricultural engineering, landscape architecture, biology, or related field.
- Proficiency with Microsoft Office programs, Adobe Suite, and ArcGIS.
- Effective verbal and written communication skills.
- Familiarity with construction documentation and specifications with the ability to perform field inspections to verify that all components of erosion and sediment pollution control and stormwater management plans are being implemented.
- Experience with erosion and sediment control, project management, best management practice (BMP) design and implementation, general construction, and BMP operation/maintenance.
- Must possess a valid PA driver's license.
- Must be able to perform physical labor and traverse various types of terrain.
